The engine is very low mileage and was put in the car some years ago by RPI in Norfolk. Ex army low compression engine - new when fitted. Very clean inside rocker cover. One of the best condition engines you will see on a P5 Rover

Engine pressure gauge reads the opposite way for some reason. But works.

Stainless steel exhaust by Double S Exhausts Devon

Electric radiator fan fitted and works well. Old fan is still available.

Insides are quite good (apparently re-upholstered by Rolls Royce) but the drivers seat needs re-colouring.

Fitted with Emergency Flasher mod.

Digital Engine Temp readout fitted

Electronic Ignition

Additional interior light fitted on ceiling

Comes with two brand new spare tyres, never used.

LED lights fitted to dash clocks etc

Clock overhauled and works ok

Driver side window winder scroll repaired.

Quite a lot of interesting older paperwork.

<u>Negatives</u>

Usual rust problems. Body etc will require a lot of work to get it back to good. Good project for someone who knows.

The roof is showing some signs of rust but I have waterproofed it for the moment so that inside does not continue to get damp. It is dry inside.

Passenger side window not working - winder scroll worn out. Window wedged up inside door.
